About us:

Organization Orfeas began functioning in August 2000. The purpose of our organization is to inform young people about international and national programs and encourage their active participation along with their European citizenship.

Furthermore, our goal is to organize and support national programs of the partner municipalities, heritage protection activities of the environment, and summer events, festivals, concerts, theatrical performances, and exhibitions in cooperation with the local municipalities. Through our activities, we try to develop solidarity and promote tolerance and understanding among young people in different countries.

Our priorities are respecting cultural diversity and fighting against racism and xenophobia. By facilitating joint activities of young people from different cultural, ethnic and religious backgrounds, Orfeas aims to develop the intercultural learning of young people making Europe a friendlier place at the same time.

An important value for the Orfeas Organization is giving all young people access, especially those with fewer opportunities, to join European youth programs and other educational activities. Through formal and non-formal learning techniques and experiences, young volunteers will improve and acquire personal, educational, and professional skills.

Project Description



In this environmental project, the volunteers work with instructors of the municipality of Xylokastro-Evrostini for the natural pine forest that is located on the coast of the town. The duration of the project is 8 weeks.

The working hours are between 08.00 to 13.00 depending on the daily plan, as for the tasks, they are given by a municipality officer, each day or as a weekly schedule. They cover seasonal needs and they mostly support the main activities of the municipality's teams.



The main tasks of the volunteers are:

- protection of the forest and the coast of Xylokastro on a weekly basis (keep the forest and the beach clean from trash)
- taking care of the natural environment of the town
- support the environmental activities of the municipality

- taking care of parks, the small harbour, the squares, and the playground in the forest
- participating in activities that are prepared for and by the local community according to the seasonal needs

- support and participate in events and activities of the youth information office promoting the ESC program
- volunteers are free to propose their environmental activities and organize their personal projects related to the main goal of the project.

About your new home - Xylokastro (Ξυλόκαστρο):

The wealth and diversity of the Greek cultural heritage, history, the mild climate, the high percentage of sunshine, and its interesting and varying landscape: A real feeling of discovery. The municipality of Xylokastro - Evrostini consists of the towns Xylokastro, Derveni, and the villages that surround them. Xylokastro is on the coast of the Corinthian Gulf in the peninsula of Peloponnesse.

The area is agricultural; there are a lot of lemon fields, as well as orange, apricot, and olive fields. Xylokastro is a small, but lively town, especially in summer, when many tourists visit the area. In Xylokastro, volunteers can find cafés, bars, night clubs, a library, many shops, supermarkets, a pine-tree forest and a beautiful beach.

- A famous place for holidays



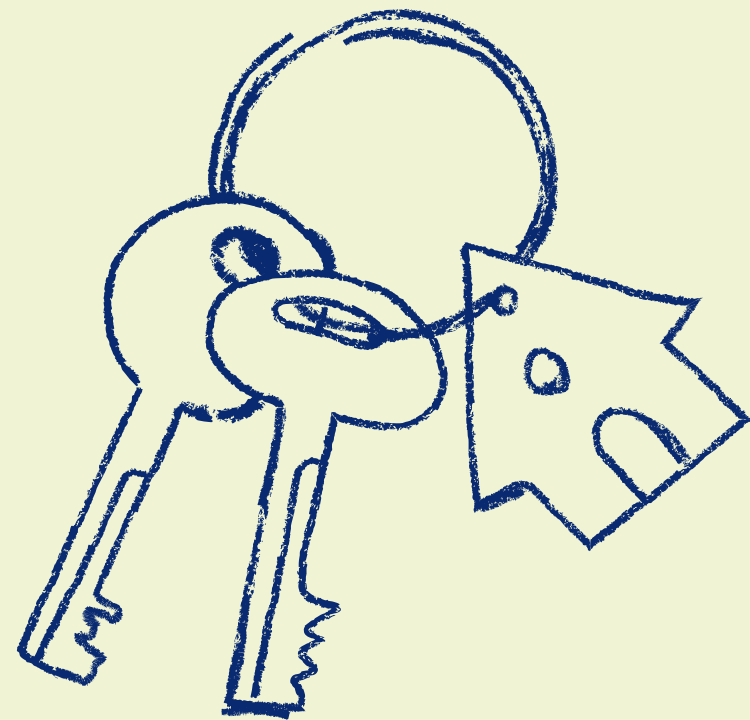


Accommodation

WHAT DO WE OFFER?

1. Mentor: every volunteer will be assigned to one of the mentors. Mentor is a member of the local community of Xylokastro. The task of the mentor is to be a help to the volunteers, especially to the one that he was assigned to. If during the project the volunteer needs any kind of support or just goes for a drink or a simple cup of coffee, the mentor is there for him.

2. Language support: volunteers will participate in a Greek language course, once per week.


3. Activities/workshops: the volunteers will participate in the activities prepared by the office team. The group of activities start from simple workshops like arts and crafts, but also cooking lessons, different theme workshops, workshops about Youthpass and learning outcomes of the project... Volunteers are free to propose their own activities.

4. Insurance: complete health insurance is provided by the Henner insurance company according to the European Commission's agreement. You will receive a confirmation e-mail with your insurance number before your project starts.

Each and every volunteer at the end of the project will receive a Youthpass certificate within the scope of the European Solidarity Corps program. The Youthpass certificate is a valuable attachment to the CV, after the project, the participants can use it while searching for a new job.
