



ABOUT US

Project description:

This project takes place in a small town, called Xylokastro, approximately two hours from Athens. The ESC duration is usually six months (depending on the agreement).

The voluntary work placement will be in the Centre of Creative Work (K.D.A.P.) which hosts children between 5–12 years old.

The aims of the project are: to introduce new activities taken by the volunteers for the daily life of the children, promote contact with new cultures and develop the artistic abilities of the children by helping the teachers in the centre during the activities.

The main tasks of the volunteers are:

- helping in organizing and developing: fine-art workshops, theatrical workshops, and music-kinetic workshops,
- providing support to the everyday needs of the centre and the children
- looking after the children in their free time,
- participating in outdoor activities and organizing cultural events, and activities with the staff,
- and the children like theatre or prose
- support and participate in events and activities of the youth information office promoting the ESC program






About your new home – Xylokastro (Ξυλόκαστρο):

The wealth and diversity of the Greek cultural heritage, history, the mild climate, the high percentage of sunshine, and its interesting and varying landscape: A real feeling of discovery. The municipality of Xylokastro – Evrostini consists of the towns Xylokastro, Derveni, and the villages that surround them. Xylokastro is on the coast of the Corinthian Gulf in the peninsula of Peloponesse.

The area is agricultural; there are a lot of lemon fields, as well as orange, apricot, and olive fields. Xylokastro is a small, but lively town, especially in summer, when many tourists visit the area. - A famous place for holidays






Accommodation

What do we offer?

1. Mentor: every volunteer will be assigned to one of the mentors. Mentor is a member of the local community of Xylokastro. The task of the mentor is to be a help to the volunteers, especially to the one that he was assigned to. If during the project the volunteer needs any kind of support or just goes for a drink or a simple cup of coffee, the mentor is there for him.

2. Language support: volunteers will participate in a Greek language course, once per week.


3. Activities/workshops: the volunteers will participate in the activities prepared by the office team. The group of activities start from simple workshops like arts and crafts, but also cooking lessons, different theme workshops, workshops about Youthpass and learning outcomes of the project... Volunteers are free to propose their own activities. 4. Insurance: complete health insurance is provided by the Henner insurance company according to the European Commission's agreement. You will receive a confirmation email with your insurance number before your project starts.
